RE: The NASU Vote

We Brothers and Sisters of the Evansville, Indiana Unchanged, Unamended Ecclesia, in April of 2004, stated our position in the Advocate, concerning whom we would fellowship with as it pertains to the NASU reunion. At that time, our Ecclesia was 100% against the reunion effort as it was being presented and our position has not changed!

It is our understanding that the Bible still teaches the ONE FAITH, ONE HOPE, ONE BAPTISM AND ONE GOD. Thereby signifying to us that there cannot be 2 substantially different beliefs within "one" faith. The amended group went out from among us, and by doing so adopted the name "amended" which means to change. If they wish to return, it would be our joy and we are sure, our Heavenly Fathers' desire to have them return to the household. It is our belief the way back would require them to be examined and submit to that "one" true baptism. We do not consider their baptism as valid nor do we recognize the gospel they accept as truth.

Furthermore, our Ecclesia does not recognize the "Self-Appointed" status of the NASU Committee, nor their authority to "compromise" our Doctrine, to those who have "Amended" and departed from God's one true Faith.

We want to make our position very clear to all. We will not meet around the table of our Lord with the Amended, the CGAF, or any other who come preaching a false gospel, nor will we break bread with anyone who does. It must be one of our sincere responsibilities to keep the Lord's table/remembrance sacred until His soon return.
