To: Brethren of the NASU Steering Committee

We have recently received your correspondence, requesting our Ecclesia to vote on the NASU “ Unity Proposal Package”.

We sincerely believe that your request for a vote on the “ Unity Proposal Package ” will not bring forth any type of reunion and will bring more division and harm to the unamended community.

As stated to you in a previous letter, we do not wish to persue this or any other unity effort unless the BUSF is totally accepted as the basis of fellowship. Anything other than this, we would consider to be false doctrine. We refuse to compromise our doctrine under which we were baptized.

We at the Monroe, Louisiana Ecclesia choose to stand apart. We as a whole Ecclesia reject the NASU Unity Proposal.

The truth of the Scripture is brought forth in the Original Unamended Statement of Faith. This is our basis of fellowship. It always has been, and will remain.

We pray for the soon return of our Master, so we might be a part of his Glory to be established on this earth. Until then, we must earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. (Jude 3)
